Child Sex Offender Arrest

The Woodstock Police Department received information from an anonymous citizen in early September of a possible convicted child sex offender operating a guitar school located at 216 Main St., Woodstock, Illinois. WPD's Criminal Investigations Division initiated an investigation into the matter and learned that the now defunct guitar school, "G4 Guitar School," was owned and operated by a "David Bruce."

The investigation disclosed that the owner of this business was actually David Bruce Colley. Colley was operating the business using his middle name, "Bruce," as his surname. David Bruce Colley is a previously convicted Child Sex Offender, who is no longer required to register as a sex offender, but is still prohibited from providing any programs or services to persons less than 18 years of age. The investigation revealed that David Bruce Colley, using the name of "David Bruce," provided guitar lessons to several students under the age of 18 at this facility from January 1, 2016, through June 30, 2016. At this time, there are no complaints of sexual abuse by Colley against the students he instructed in Woodstock.

Upon conferring with the McHenry County State's Attorney's Office, charges were approved and an arrest warrant issued for Colley for: Child Sex Offender Unlawfully Providing Programs or Services to Persons under 18 Years of Age. On October 13th, 2016, Colley was arrested while performing a musical act at a local City of McHenry establishment by the McHenry Police Department. Colley posted his \$1,000 bond (10% of \$10,000) and was released pending his initial court date.
