Fatal Traffic Crash

Woodstock Police Department responded to Illinois Route 14 and Kishwaukee Valley Road at 7:39 pm. on Sunday, September 20, 2015 for a motor vehicle accident.

Investigation revealed that the driver (a 39 year old male resident of Lake in the Hills, Illinois) of a 2004 Chevrolet Express 2500 Van was traveling southeast bound on Route 14 at Kishwaukee Valley Road. An 18 year old male subject, formerly of Cary, Illinois, was westbound on Kishwaukee Valley Road on a Huffy Edge 10 speed Mountain Bike. Witnesses on the scene, and the driver of the involved Chevrolet Van, reported that the bicyclist attempted to cross Route 14 on a red traffic signal. The bicyclist was not wearing a helmet, the bicycle was not equipped with lights and the bicyclist was wearing dark colored clothing.

The bicyclist was transported to Centegra Memorial Hospital, Woodstock, Illinois by the Woodstock Fire/Rescue Department where approximately 2 hours after the crash he succumbed to injuries received in the crash

Route 14 was closed to traffic between Dean Street and Illinois Route 120 until approximately 01:00 am. while members of the Major Crash Investigation Team investigated the crash. The Major Crash Investigation Team is staffed by police personnel from Woodstock, McHenry, Johnsburg and Spring Grove Police Departments.

While the investigation continues, there are no charges at this time nor are alcohol/drugs suspected as being a factor in this crash.

The name of the deceased is not being released until family notification has been made.
