On Monday, December 29, 2014 at 3:30 P.M., the Woodstock Police Department responded to a residence located in the 1100 block of N. Madison St., regarding an armed robbery in progress.

The two victims in the armed robbery, 17 and 19 year old males from Woodstock, provided a description of the four offenders and the vehicle the offenders were utilizing in fleeing from the scene.

Responding patrol officers located the vehicle in the immediate area of the reported armed robbery and initiated an investigative traffic stop. The four occupants of the vehicle in question, which matched the description of the alleged robbers, were taken into custody and detained. (All identified below).

Woodstock detectives responded to the scene and continued the investigation of the armed robbery. The investigation revealed that the two victims involved in this incident arranged a drug transaction for a small amount of cannabis with one of the subjects taken into custody. During the arranged drug transaction, one of the offenders displayed a pellet gun, substantially similar to a real firearm, and stole approximately 3 grams of cannabis and attempted to steal the victims' cellular telephones. A pellet gun, matching the description of the firearm used in the armed robbery, was located in the glove compartment of the offenders' vehicle during the initial detention of the offenders.

After conferring with the McHenry County States Attorney's Office, each of the four offenders was charged with one count of Aggravated Robbery (a class 1 felony). Nicholas A. Sanfilippo, was charged with an additional count of Resisting a Peace Officer (a class A misdemeanor), as he resisted efforts by detectives to place him into a temporary holding cell at the Woodstock Police Department.

All offenders were subsequently transported to the McHenry County Adult Correctional Facility, whereas of December 30th they remain in custody.
