Dear Resident,

This letter is being distributed to the residents on Tappan Street as an update of the current construction status. Work on Phase 2 of the storm sewer project is scheduled to begin on Thursday – September 8, 2016.

Assuming favorable weather conditions for construction, the updated schedule will consist of the following activities:

- Begin excavation at a point in the Tappan Street pavement approximately 200 feet north of the intersection of Terry Court. Continue excavation southeasterly toward the east edge curb line on Tappan Street and then southerly past Terry Court and ending at Ash Avenue.
- Continue installation of large-diameter storm sewer pipe and manholes in the excavated trench.
- Filling excavated trenches and topping off with stone and asphalt grindings.
- Restoring disturbed areas with topsoil, seed and blanket.
- Opening roadway and resumption of normal traffic and parking conditions.
- The road will remain open during the work, however flaggers and signage will be utilized to direct traffic.

The above work is expected to be completed by the end of October, 2016. The City appreciates your patience and understanding while this work is being completed.
